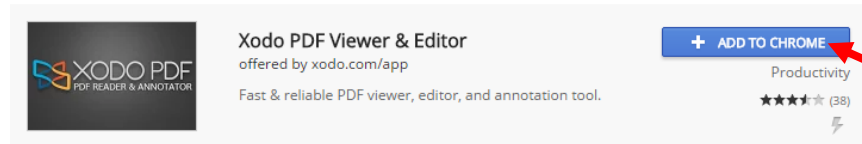



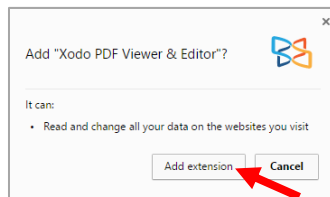
How to Install the XODO PDF Extension for Chrome

XODO is available as an extension from the Chrome Web Store.

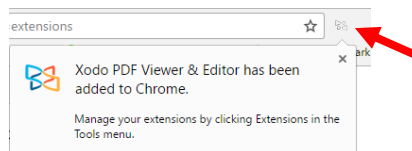
1. Open Google Chrome and sign in to your account.
2. Go to the Web Store <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/> and type **XODO** into the search box. Press ENTER.
3. Choose the Extensions option and the Free option.
4. The extension is shown in the right pane.



5. Click the *Add to Chrome* button. 
6. Click *Add extension* on the confirmation box.

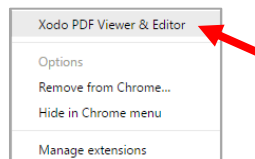



7. The XODO extension icon is added to the browser toolbar.

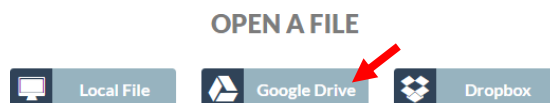


To Annotate a TechnoKids Assignment in XODO

1. Click the XODO icon in the browser toolbar and choose *XODO PDF Editor & Viewer*.

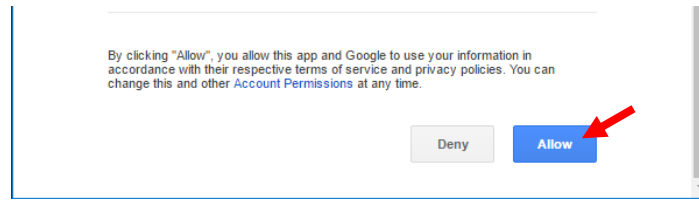


2. Click *Launch Now*  on the XODO page.
3. Under *Open a File*, choose *Google Drive*.



4. The first time you launch XODO you will be prompted to allow the app permission to access your files.

5. Click **Allow**.



6. Browse to select the PDF file and click *Select* to open.

Answer Questions and Add Comments

1. Use the tools on the XODO toolbar to manage your document: add text, comments, or highlighting; zoom in or out, save the changes; and print the document.



2. When you are done, click the *Save* arrow and choose **Google Drive**. This saves the changes to the document right in Google Drive.
3. Click *Print* to print your work.
4. Close the browser tab.
5. Sign out of Google Drive.
