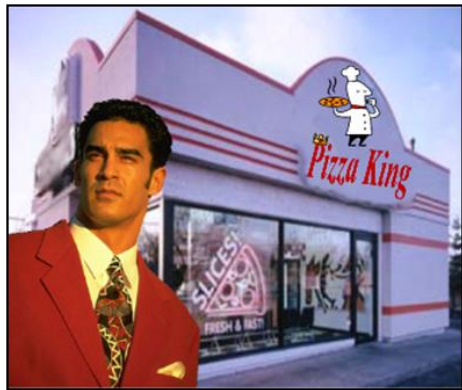

Future Link Plans to Connect Satellite TV and High Speed

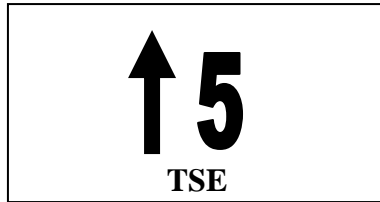
Future Link Takes a Major Step Forward in Joining the TV with the Internet by Announcing Plans to Develop New Technology
