

Session 2 Extension Activity: Morph Your Photo

PhotoFiltre is a very powerful program. You can experiment with some of the interesting effects to create some really wacky photographs of yourself. Have fun!

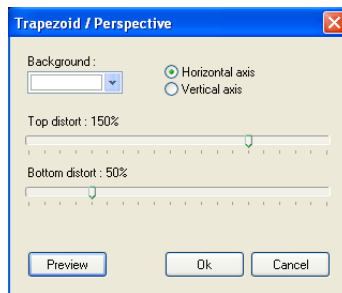
Open your Picture and Select Deform



- ☞ Open PhotoFiltre.
- ☞ Click the *Open* tool on the Standard toolbar or select *Open* from the File menu.
- ☞ Choose one of your photograph files, such as a close up of your face.
- ☞ From the Filter menu, select *Deform*.

Experiment with Trapezoid/Perspective

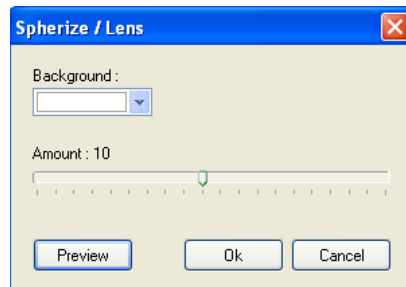
- ☞ Select *Trapezoid/Perspective*. Adjust the sliders for the Horizontal axis and for the Vertical axis. Click *Preview* each time to view the distortion.



- ☞ Click *Cancel* to return to the original photograph.

Experiment with Spherize/Lens

- ☞ Select *Spherize/Lens*. Adjust the slider, previewing the results each time.



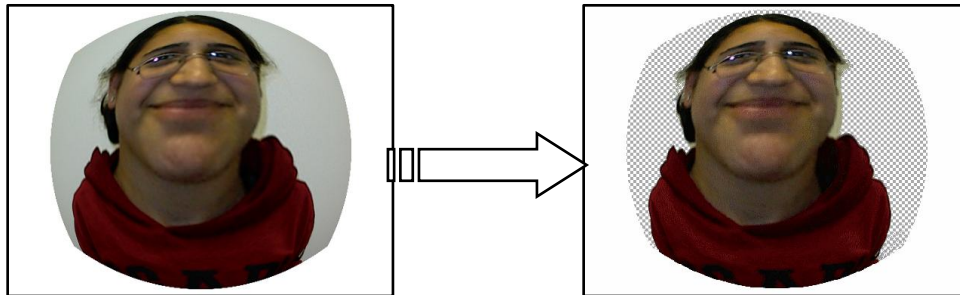
- ☞ Click *Cancel* to return to the original photograph.

Experiment with Remainder of Deform Options

- ☞ Continue to explore with the Deform options: *Twirl*, *Ripple*, *Glass*, and *Lake Reflection*.
- ☞ Select your favorite photo.

Make the Photograph Transparent

- ☞ Under the Image menu, select *Transparent Color*.
- ☞ You may need to remove two background colors: the original background and the white border created by the distortions. Make one background color transparent and when it looks good, click *OK*.



- ☞ Under the Image menu, click *Transparent Color* a second time. Select *Merge with current transparency*.
- ☞ Use the eyedropper tool to select the remaining background color that you would like to make transparent. Click *Preview*.



- ☞ When you like it, click *OK*.

Save the Photograph

- ☞ Save the photo with the name **deform**. You may wish to use this photo in your movie!
