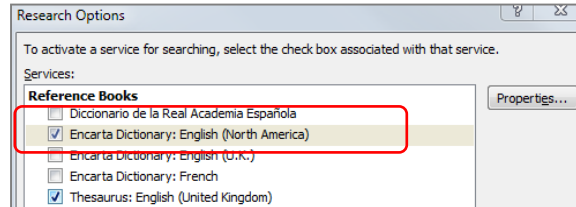
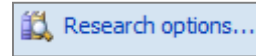
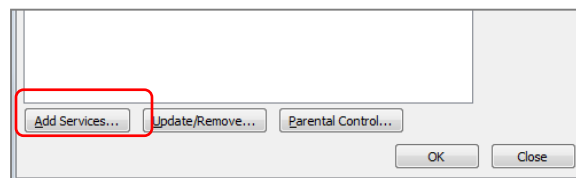


How to Add Research Options Services in Office 2007 or Office 2010

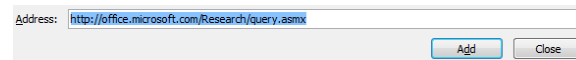
1. If your computer does not display the Encarta dictionary, from the Review tab, click Research.
2. At the bottom of the Research pane, click *Research options*.
3. If you see, Encarta Dictionary, select it, then click *OK*.



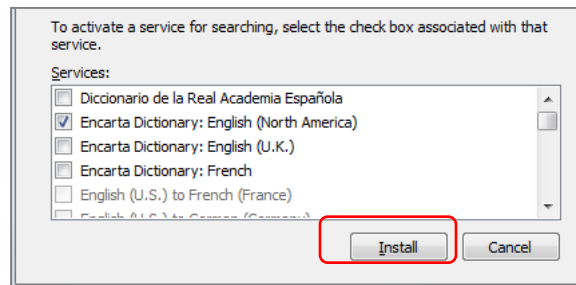
4. If you do not see it, click *Add Services*.



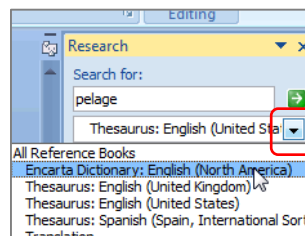
5. In the Address bar, type <http://office.microsoft.com/Research/query.aspx> and click *Add*.



6. Click *Install*.



7. Click *OK*.
8. You will now see the Encarta Dictionary in the list. Click *OK* again.
9. To test it out, type the word **pelage** in your document. Select the word. Now click the *Research Command*. Does it automatically show the definition? If not, click the Reference type *arrow* and select Encarta Dictionary. Does it work now?
