


Assignment 8: Visit the Video Theater at the e-Media Center

The e-Media Center has so many fun things to do. As part of your trip, visit the Video Theater to watch videos.

You will be surprised how much there is to see! The Internet has a huge video collection. A video can be a report about a recent event, an interview with a famous person, a 'how-to' instructional piece, sports highlight, or a funny clip. Many videos can be a great source of information. Not only are they fun to watch, but often you can get more facts quickly.



Use your skills to find videos on the Internet.

Add the Video Stamp to the Passport

- ☞ Use your skills to add the **videos** stamp to the passport.
- Now you can access the videos in the *Video Theater* of the e-Media Center.



Visit the Video Theatre and Bookmark It in a Media Folder

- ☞ Open Internet Explorer. 
- ☞ In the address bar, type **www.google.com**. Press ENTER.
- ☞ Click *Videos*.



- ☞ (Optional) **IF YOU DO NOT HAVE** a **Media** folder in either the Favorites Center or your Bookmarks folder create one:

Favorites Center

- a) Click *Favorites*. 
- b) Right click on **your name** folder.
- c) Select *Create new folder*.
- d) Type **Media** and press ENTER.

Bookmarks Folder

- a) Go to the Bookmarks folder.
- b) Right click a blank area of the window.
- c) Point to *New* and select *Folder*.
- d) Type **Media** and press ENTER.

TIP: If you do not know how to use bookmarks, refer to the instructions in Assignment 4 in Session 1.

Use your skills to bookmark the web page in your **Media** folder.

Favorites Center

- a) Click *Favorites*. 
- b) Click *Add to Favorites*.
- c) Edit the **name** in the *Name:* box.
- d) Select **Media** in *Create in:* box.
- e) Click *Add*.

Bookmarks Folder

- a) Copy the URL from the address bar.
- b) Go to the **Media** folder.
- c) Right click a blank area of the window.
- d) Point to *New* and select *Shortcut*.
- e) Paste the URL into the *location* box.
- f) Type a **name** for the shortcut. Click *Finish*.



Watch Educational Videos



A *documentary* is a factual film or video that gives details about an event, person, or topic by giving you the facts with little or no fiction.

~🔊 Pretend you need to write a report about **polar bears**. Find a video with facts about the animal.

~🔊 In the search box, type **polar bears**. Click *Search*. Select a video.

A *speech* is a lecture, or talk, a person gives to an audience to express their thoughts and emotions.

A *demonstration* is a visual description of how to do something with examples to explain the process. When a person says 'let me show you how', they are *demonstrating* to you how to do something.




