**MONEY GROWS ON TREES?**



Money doesn't grow on trees. People use this saying when someone asks them for money they do not have. They say "Do you think money grows on trees?" because the person asking seems to think they have an unlimited supply of cash. As if they have a tree they can just pick from whenever a person wants money.
