

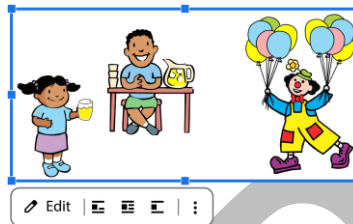
Session 4 Skill Review: Balloon Trouble

As an editor, you know what needs to be added to have a story makes sense. Use your skills to explain the story action in the comic *Balloon Trouble*.

In the comic, a boy and girl sell a glass of lemonade to a clown. You will need to add shapes, text boxes, and Word art to tell what happens in this silly story.



1. Ask your teacher for the **comic** file. Open it in Google Docs.
2. Select the first comic panel. Click *Edit* to open it in Drawings.



3. Ungroup the objects:
 - a. Select the images. Click *Actions* OR right click on the grouped objects.
 - b. Pick *Ungroup*.
 - c. Click on the canvas to deselect the objects.
4. Enlarge each object to fill the canvas.
5. Use your skills to explain what is happening.

	Draw a line.		Set the start or end point of a line.
	Draw a shape.		Fill an object with color or gradient.
	Make a text box.		Set the outline color of an object.
	Insert Word art.		Pick the border weight.
	Adjust the object order.		Choose the border dash style.

6. When you have finished a comic panel, click *Save and Close*.
