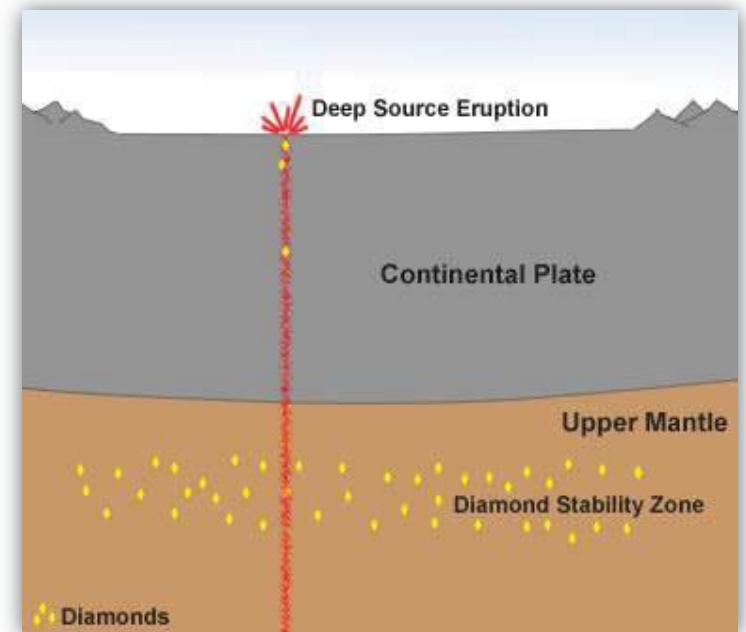

# Fun Facts about Diamonds

## Hardness

Diamonds are rated 10 on the hardness level. They are one of the hardest natural materials.

## Weight

Diamonds are weighed in carats. A carat is 200 milligrams. The heavier the diamond the more valuable.

## Color

Diamonds can be white, pink, blue, and yellow.
